

The benefits the Elizabeth line will bring to your event





In December this year, a brand new train service will open which will change the face of London and the way that you travel to ExCeL.



Services will commence on the Elizabeth line (Crossrail) in December 2018, with a 43 minute direct service from Heathrow to ExCeL's onsite Crossrail station from December 2019.



12 trains per hour, each carrying up to 1,500 visitors in comfort
Total travel time to Heathrow with a change at Paddington (until direct route is running), is 36 minutes



Oyster / smart cards accepted



Trains will leave Heathrow every 15 minutes



There will be 40 Crossrail stations across London



The Crossrail route will run over 100km from Reading to Shenfield

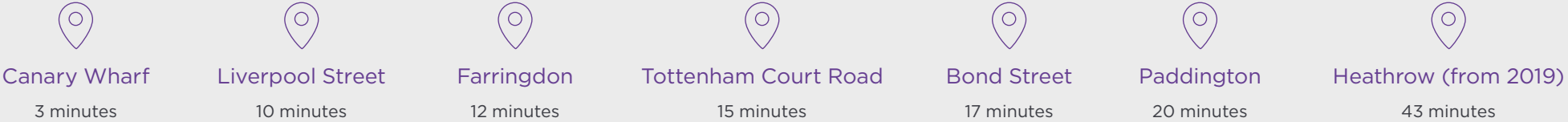
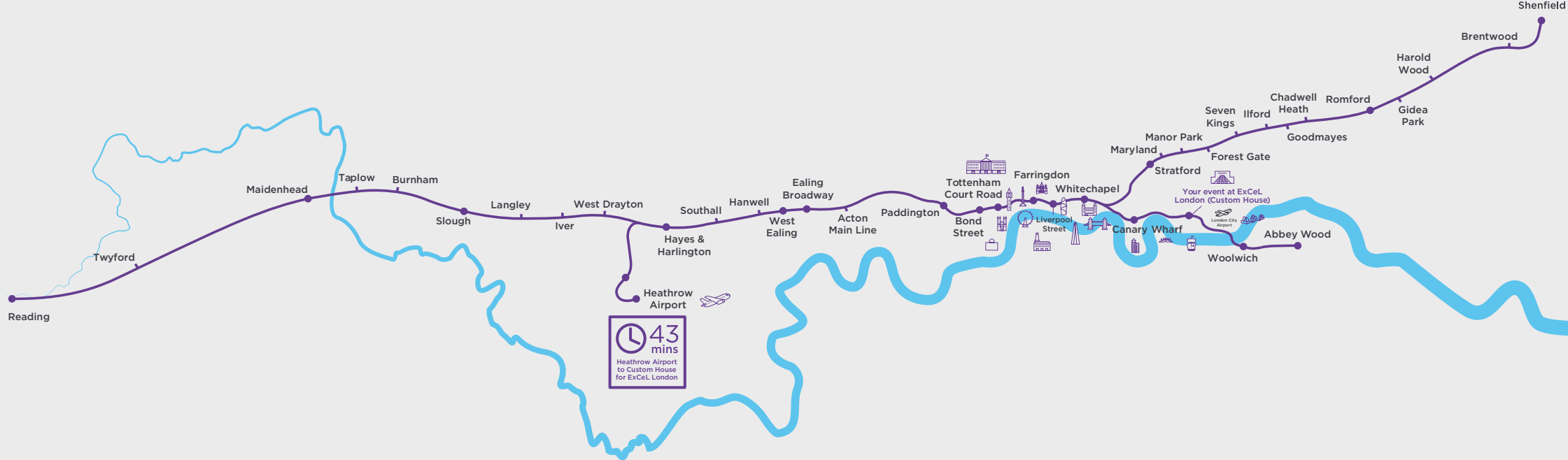


A train every 2.5 minutes at peak time through central London
